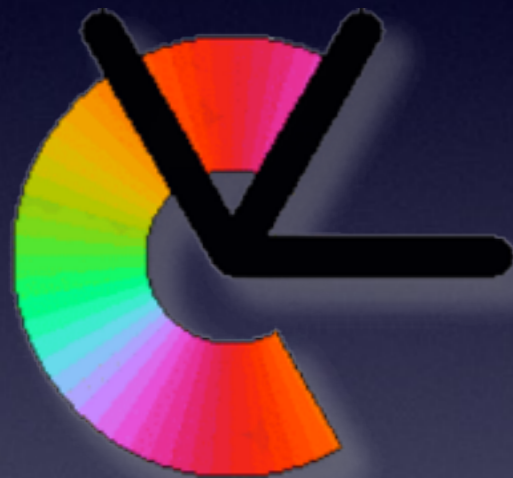

- preliminära resultat som kan demonstreras vid halvtidskontroll

Rapporten skall lämnas till examinator för godkännande.
